4. Jusu Ministered in Southern Sierra Leone during Christmas. Through diligent prayer and effort, by God's grace, they **showed** the Jesus film three different times to audiences of 176, 225, and 156 people. 63 people chose to follow Christ, most of whom were from a village that has no church. Jusu has plans to follow up with Bible Studies.

One obstacle that Jusu met was a canceled paid reservation for the village's communal area. Instead, the chief gave it to the women's secret society which conducts harmful practices such as female genital mutilation. God's provisions to overcome the obstacle were permission from Jusu's non-Christian family who allowed the movie viewings on their family property and money loaned to transport neighbors from the neighboring village so they could come to watch the film and discuss it afterwards. The program was from 9pm-1am.

<u>Elementary Teacher Scholarship Sponsor Program:</u> As Transformation Education trained 24 total college students in 2023, we discovered how difficult it is for them to pay their college fees. Different than typical college students currently we serve students who voluntarily teach in very poor rural schools during the school year, then take their college courses during school vacations, with the plan to eventually be put on the payroll.

Now that we are aware of their burden, we are inviting sponsorship to impact many lives by sponsoring a hard-working teacher.

Total Sponsorship per student is \$1,800, providing a three year credited college teaching certificate.

Optional **payment plans** include: \$50/month for 36 months, \$600/year for 3 years or \$1,800 onetime payment. Whichever plan chosen please make a note: Designate Scholarship. Each scholarship recipient will receive: paid tuition and allowance for transportation, lunch, and housing.

By May 31st the new 2024 students will have been selected. **Sponsors will get their first of nine sponsorship letter by October 2024.** Students will attend college July 2024-August 2027.
