The teachers and students are showing good progress in their ability to make rhymes, read and write using phonics also in the implementation of Biblical Character Education.


The scheduled June 2023 Presidential Elections activities are causing the school year to be cut short. Thus we are preparing materials for the children to be able to continue practicing while they are at home.

Aminata's make a living cooking. Her pots and utensils were stolen. Mohammed was accused because he doesn't have a job, yet his children somehow afford school fees. Community members were bullying Mohamed's children so he said he would pay it back. Aminata took that as him admitting he was involved and had the police put him in jail. Transformation Education staff discovered this as they went for Wednesday Bible Study. If Mohamed would be in jail three nights he would be sent to prison with little chance of a fair trial and getting out in a reasonable time. TE staff encouraged the Aminata and the community members to bail Mohammed and give him time to pay for the stolen goods, even though we are still not certain he is the thief. Prayers that these types of Grateful interventions teach and transform the community.
